

NWOS Research Questions


- Who owns America's forests?

History of the NWOS



NWOS Methods

- Part of FIA
- Probability proportional to size sample design
- Self-administered, mailbased paper questionnaire
 - With telephone follow-up
- Most recent data:
 - 2011-2013
 - n = 8,576
 - Coop. rate = 51.6%




