COVID-19 In-Person Meeting Safety Protocol (Canada Only)

NCASI continues to host in-person meetings. While most NCASI in-person meetings will include a hybrid option with enhanced meeting capabilities, we are comfortable that in-person meetings can be held safely if proper precautions are in place, as follows:

- We encourage in-person meeting attendees to be vaccinated.
- All attendees are expected to closely monitor themselves for COVID-19 symptoms before and throughout the meeting.
- In consideration of fellow attendees, we ask that anyone experiencing symptoms not attend in person.
- Everyone will be encouraged to use hand sanitizer throughout the meeting.
- A limited number of COVID-19 antigens test kits will be available for those that wish to test themselves during the meeting.
- If, while at the meeting, you experience COVID-19 symptoms you are asked not to attend the meeting in-person. Please electronically request a rapid antigen self-test from NCASI staff. Anyone who experiences symptoms or tests positive should not attend the meeting in person, and instead join virtually, if available.
